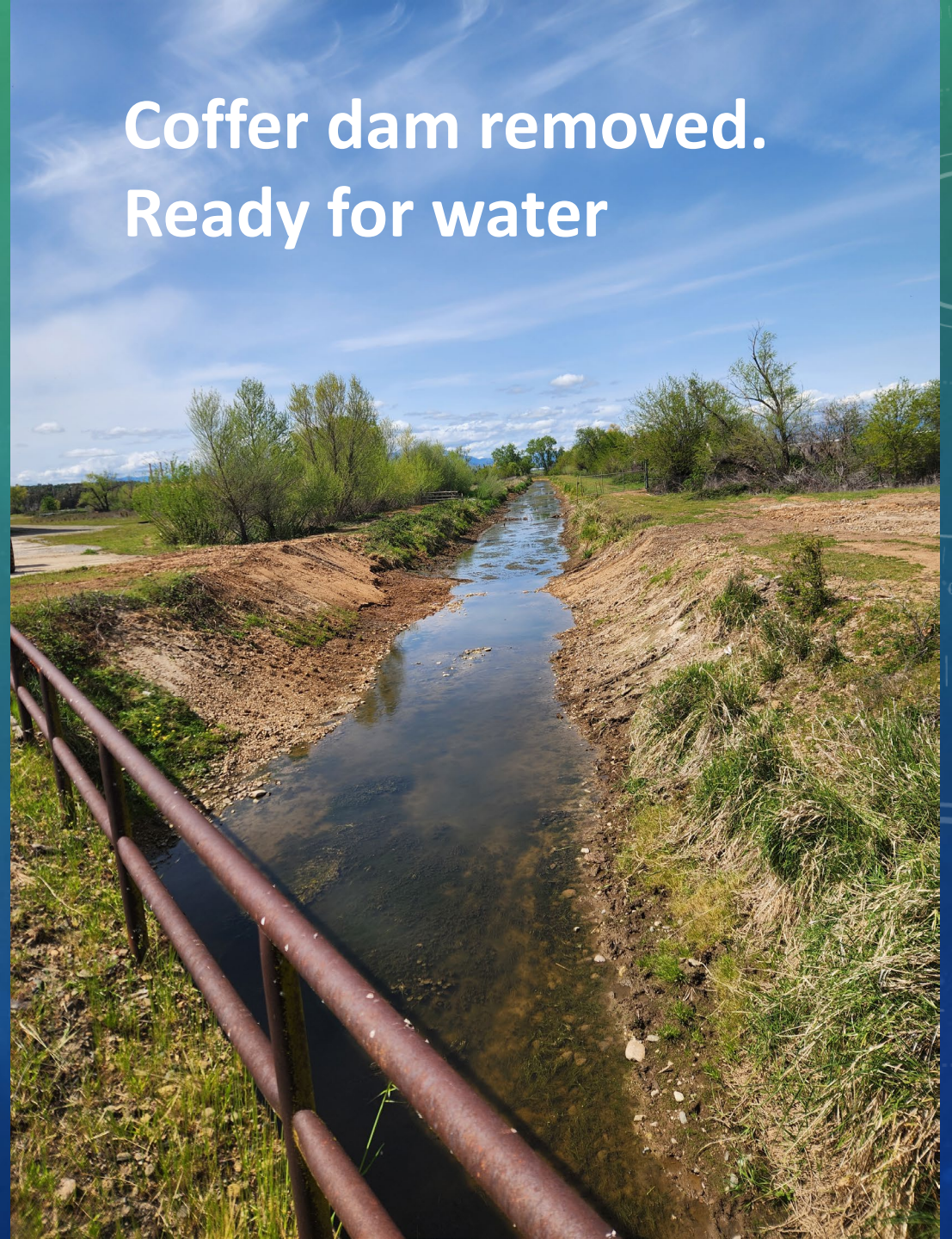

4/11/25 – Complete Diversion installation

4/12-4/13 – Last weekend of Freedom

4/14/25 – Install Olney Creek Structure

4/15/25 – 4am open Drum Gate to charge canal at 100CFS/Start Churn Creek Pumps

4/15-4/18 – Debris removal From Main Canal and Churn Creek

4/18/25 – increase flows to 150-200cfs

4/19-4/20 – Open Lateral 29

4/21/25 – Start Churn Creek irrigation/ Begin Main Canal rotation
